The evaluation sentences (right hand side of each pair) are temporally reversed, as presented in the Rating experiment (Section 3.2).

### ● Comparison with Target Speaker (TS)

- ▶ TS speaking English — Condition J: RS speaking Japanese natively
- ▶ TS speaking English — Condition VC: Voice Conversion in Japanese
- ▶ TS speaking English — Condition AM: Accent Morphing in Japanese

- ▶ RS speaking Japanese — Condition E: TS speaking Japanese with an English accent
