






## Some Points from ISCA by-laws on SIGs

- At least two elected officers : Chairperson and Secretary
  - Elections held every two years.
  - Must be members of ISCA.
  - Re-election is possible, but consecutive appointments are limited to four successive terms.
- A Liaison Representative responsible for communication with members of SIG and ISCA Board.
- Shall provide annual report to Board
- At least 25 members in the SIG
- ISCA Board may choose to close a SIG failure to adhere to required procedures, inactivity over a period of years, or divergence from interests of Association.





#### Audio Visual Speech (AVISA) - Plans


- Events: AVISA officially began in 1998; the founding members of the Auditory-Visual speech processing (AVSP) community have recently retired or are on the verge of doing so. The AVISA executive has plans in place to record brief interviews (via zoom, etc) with these doyens of the community and post them on youtube.
- We have created a Youtube channel for this series: "AVSP Visionaries".
- These interviews will be of interest to AVSP researchers, and the speech research community more broadly. They will also serve to preserve AVSP history. To add uniformity, we have developed: a template style for the interviews, format, some standard(ish) questions (with some personal touches for a specific interviewee) and mapped out a list of who to interview (some have been approved and agreed).
- A test run has been recorded (to ensure that the Zoom format is of sufficient quality) and we have interested parties potentially willing to commit funds to cover production costs.





## Audio Visual Speech (AVISA) - Plans

- Elections: We are planning to hold elections for all of the executive positions of AVISA. The committee suggested we take this slowly; develop a curated candidate list first to build interest
- Social media: We have continued to promote AVISA through the twitter account AV\_SP - now ~2000 followers and ~ 8,500 posts!



#### SPeaker & Language Ch. (SpLC): Outcomes

- EVENTS
  - Odyssey 2022: The Speaker and Language Recognition Workshop
    - June 28th -July 1st 2022, Beijing (China)
    - Local organizers: Tsinghua University, Xinjiang University, Xiamen University, and Duke Kunshan University.
    - COVID-19 situation caused the originally planned physical workshop to be fully online.
    - 77 submissions, 59 accepted (acceptance rate of 76.6%)
    - 3 keynotes, 4 tutorials, 10 sessions, 1 best paper award and 1 Jack Godfrey best student paper award.
    - 131 registered attendees; due to time difference issue, the peak online attendees reached ~90
    - The workshop also featured a **CN-Celeb Speaker Recognition Challenge 2022** (CNSRC 2022) focusing on real-world scenarios, with 132 team registered, 55 teams submissions (26 valid).
